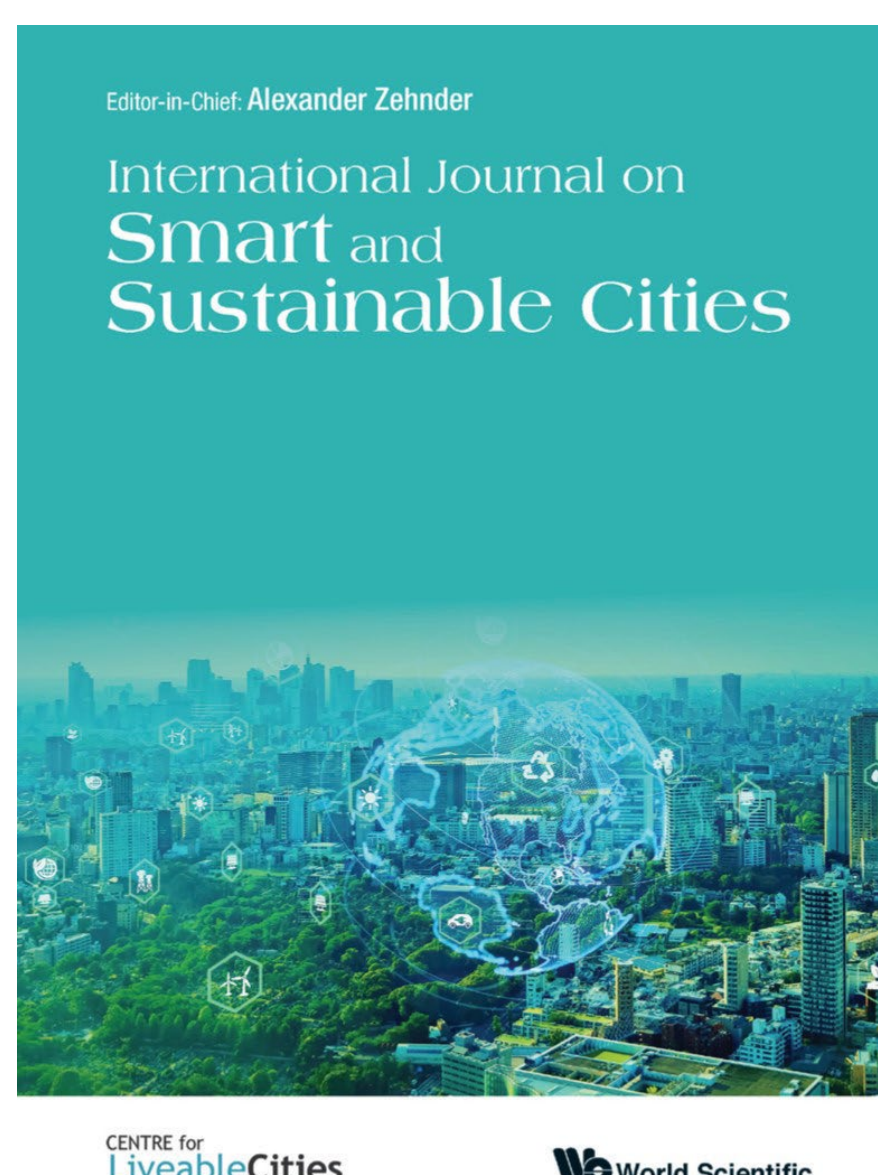
Enhancing Cities' Liveability and Sustainability in the Face of Climate Change
