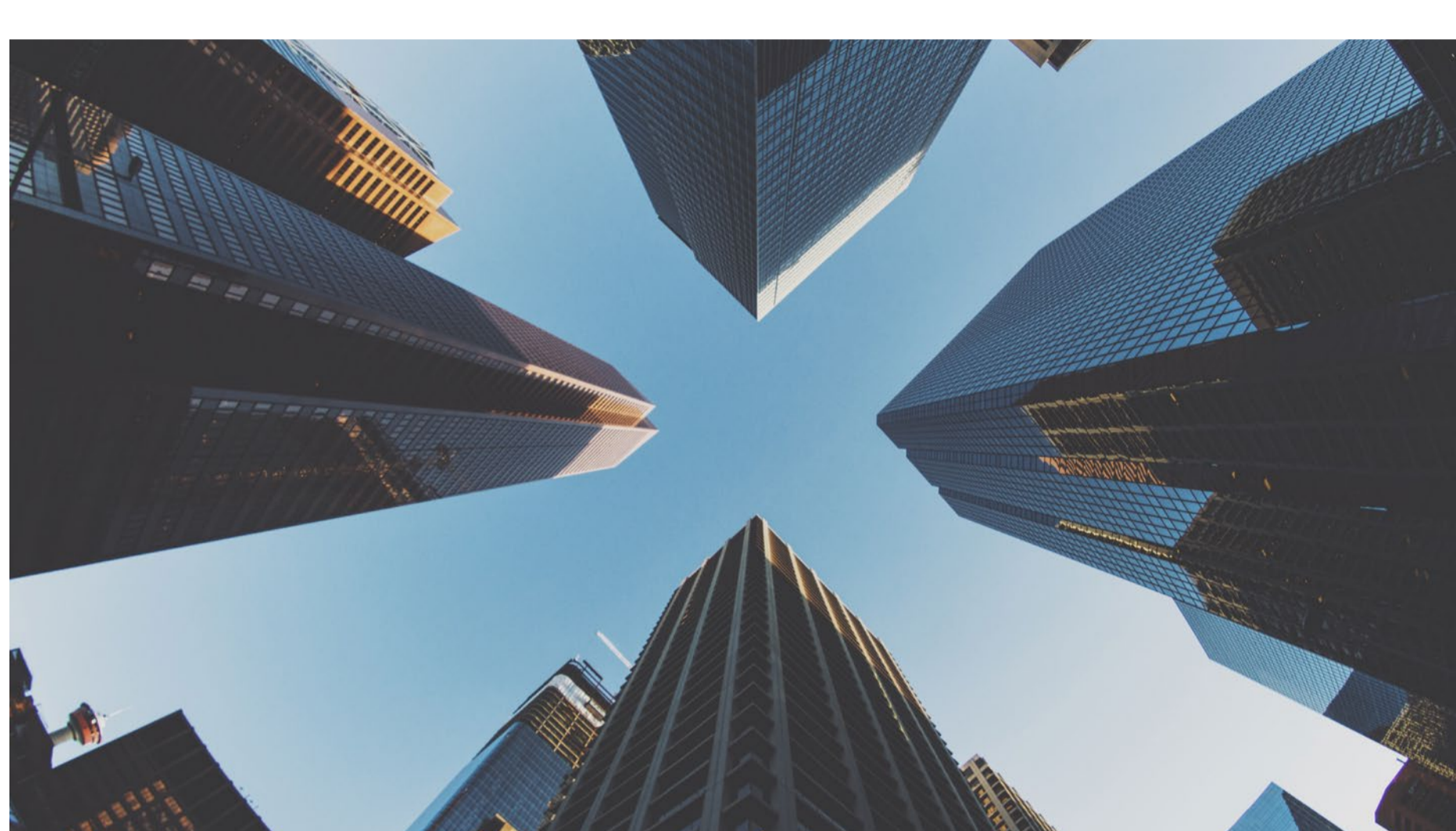
## Designing a Dementia-Friendly Neighbourhood in Singapore

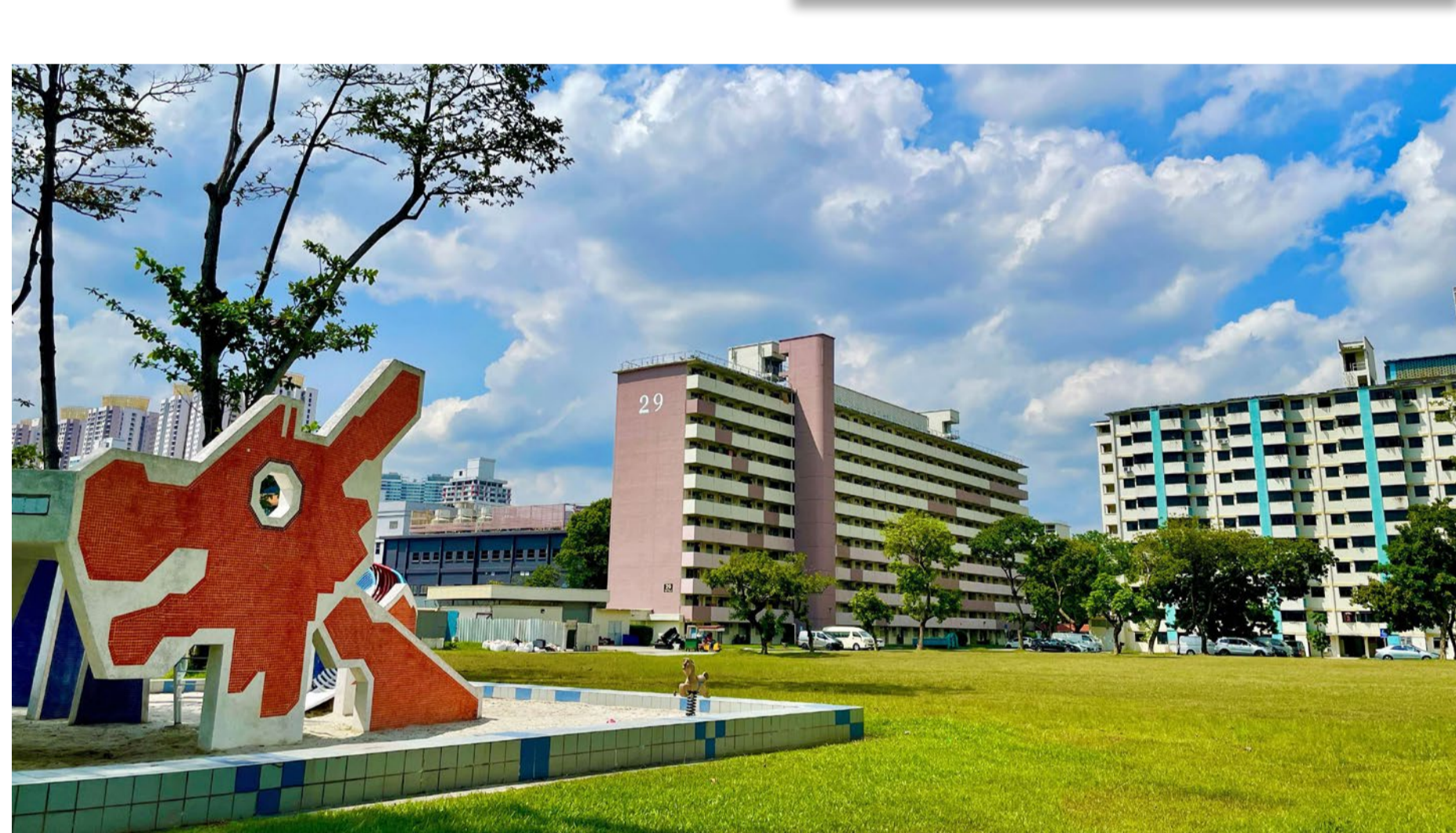

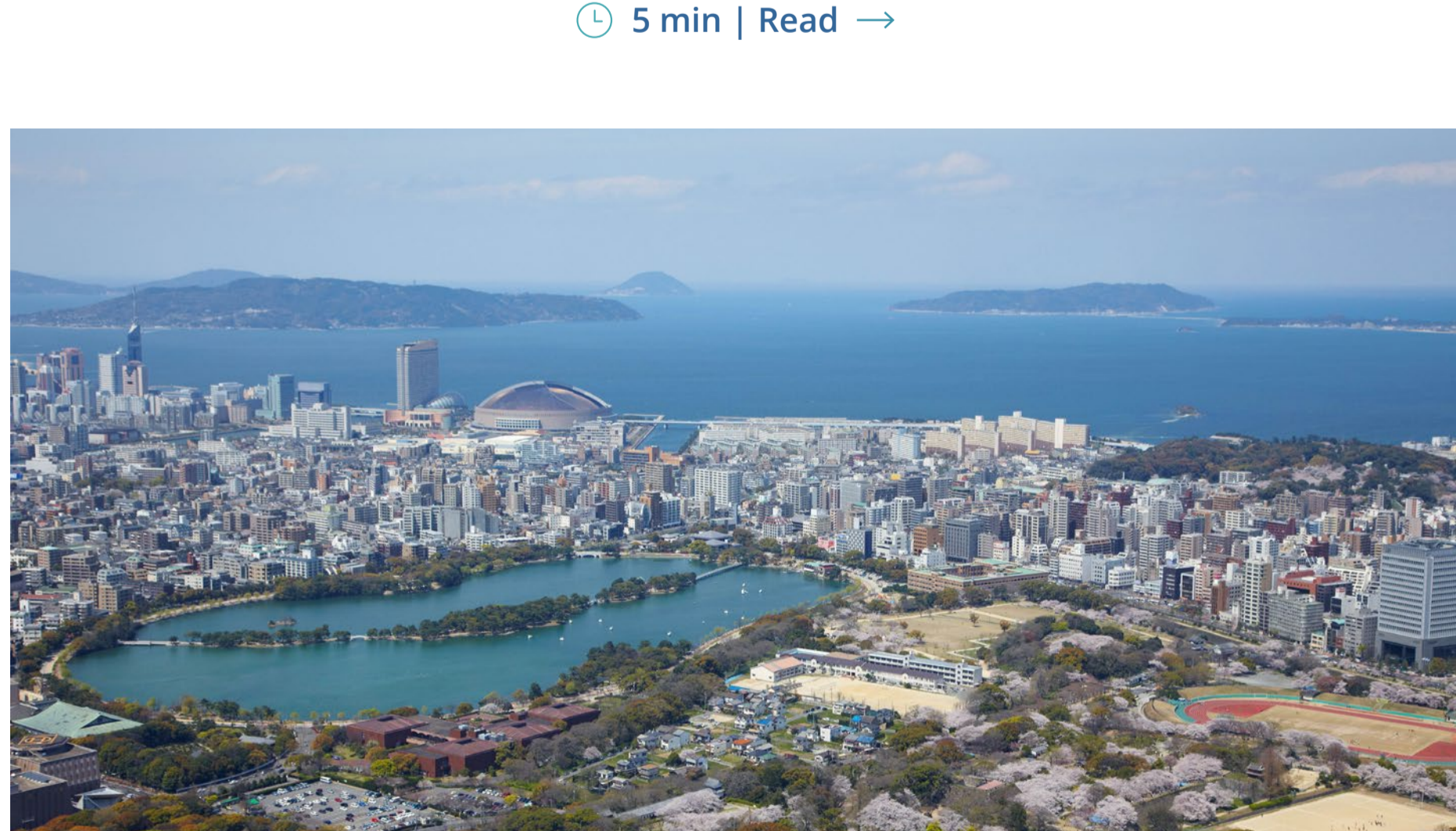

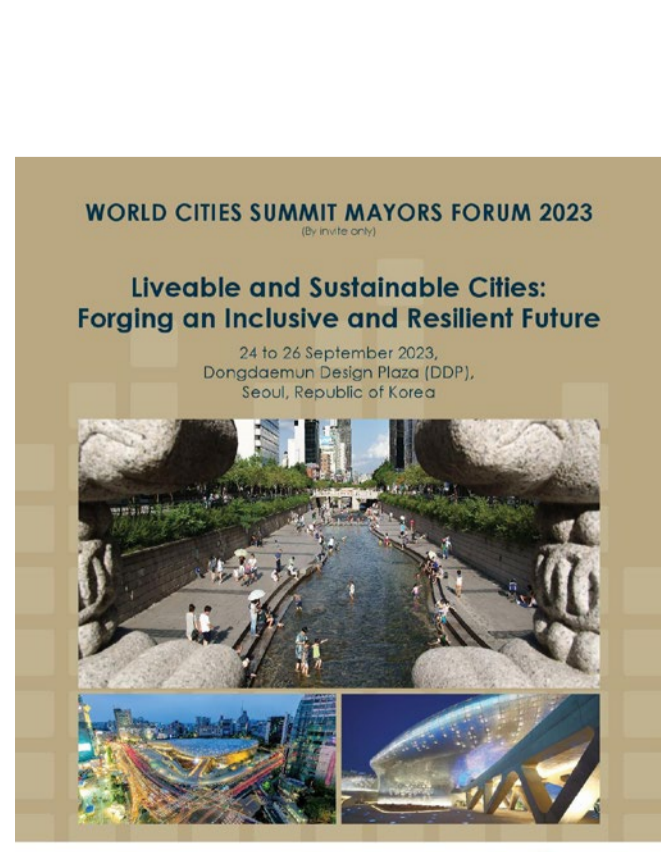
