Cities are at the vanguard of facing and solving some of the most pressing challenges facing humanity like climate change, social cohesion and technological disruptions. More than half the world now live in cities – and this number will increase to two-thirds by 2050.

Many megacities are rising in Asia and elsewhere. However, governing cities to be liveable and sustainable is one of the most complex jobs.

Unlike in the business world where business schools and advanced management programmes exist, there are no training programmes for those who are or are about to become mayors and city leaders.



Why choose AUGP?

Singapore's Centre for Liveable Cities (CLC) aims to fill this gap with the inaugural Advanced Urban Governance Programme (AUGP). At the completion of AUGP, participants can attend the World Cities Summit (WCS) from 5 – 9 July 2020.

CLC will build on its repertoire of practical knowledge in running its renowned Leaders in Urban Governance Programmes over the last decade, attended by over 2,000 global city leaders.

The curriculum of AUGP will be based on

- 1 Practical case studies and the Urban Systems Studies (USS) series on Singapore
- 2 Insights and knowledge from CLC's network of 400 cities, including Laureate cities of the prestigious Lee Kuan Yew World City Prize
