POSTER PRESENTATION			
25	Presentation submitted can be presented clearly, concisely and in sufficient detail within a A0 portrait orientated poster.		
26	Sections to be included in the poster are the same as that of an oral presentation, i.e., 1) Research background, 2) Research aims/questions, 3) Methods, 4) Findings, 5) Discussion and conclusions addressing the research aims/questions.
